It was moved by Mr. Lyons, seconded by Mr. Crane and carried that the Mayor appoint a committee to work with the Clerk to get Ordinances and Resolutions, organized, entered and typed in their respective books by Jan. 1, 1952. Mr. Lyons, Mr. Schell and Mr. Anthony were appointed to serve on the above committee.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the Council accept the contract submitted by the Washington Township Trustees for fire protection for the Village of Centerville, amounting to \$600.00 per annum. The contract being dated as of Nov. 1, 1951. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.
