It was moved by Mr. Crane, seconded by Mr. Propheter and carried that we (the Council) will pay for one fire plug on West Ridgeway while Mr. Gorman will furnish one and will install both plugs at his expense, A roll call resulted in 5 Ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Lyons, seconded by Mr. Crane and carried that the Mayor's records be audited at the time he leaves office. A roll call resulted in 5 eyes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Schell Moved that Resolution No.1-1951, being a resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor, seconded by Mr. Propheter and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 eyes in favor of the motion.

The Clerk was ordered to get credit card from the Pure Oil Station to be used by Deputy Marshall for Cruiser.
