Mr. Schweizer made the following motion, "I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three distinct and separate days be dispensed with so that Ord. 2-1950 may be given its second and third readings", seconded by Mr. Fox and carried. A roll call-resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Said Ord.2-1950 was given its 2nd and 3rd readings.

The question being, shall said Ord. 2-1950 be passed?

It was moved by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Crane and carried that

Ord.2-1950 be passed. aA roll call was ordered which resulted

in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Then, Mr. Schell introduced Res. No. 1-1950, being "A Resolution to accept the proposal of the Dayton Power and Light Company to revemp the Village of Centerville's Lighting System" seconded by Mr. Anthony and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Schweizer, and carried that the Council approve the Zengel plat subject to PerforMance approval of \$25000. bond . A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Mr. Anthony, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the Council sign the petition to . create Holes Creek Sanitery District. This being signed by the Mayor and President of Council. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.
