The minutes of the meetings of September 27, 1966 and October 31, 1966 were read and approved.

Mr. R. Rioden representing Senate Builders presented the proposed layout of the area east of the Bargain Barn for which he has applied for rezoning (Z-1-66). The Commission was generally in favor of this use of the land but hesitant to approve rezoning to business since this would permit development other than that proposed. Further consideration was tabled pending information from the Solicitor on how we could guarantee development as proposed.

Ralph Sharp Inc. presented plans for an entrance to Village South (North Village Dr.). It was moved by Schell, seconded by Butler and unanimously agreed that approval be recommended. (Plans by Igleburger and Henderson - October 13, 1966).
