Samples of chain-link galvanized fence with aluminum slats were shown. This type fence, in dark green and a minimum of six feet high was recommended for the west boundary of the Centerville Commercial Park where it borders residential property.

R. Miller, representing Centerville Commercial Park, presented engineering and construction drawing for Westpark Road. These were Tabled until the Village Engineer could review them.

Record plan and construction drawing were presented for Village South - Section 7A. These had been reviewed by the Village Engineer who reported they were all in order and recommended bond be set at \$6500. Butler moved, Purdin seconded and it was unanimously carried that it be recommended to Council that these be approved.

A preliminary and tentative lay-out for future sections of Pleasant Hill was presented. The commission suggested that some alternate street locations be considered to avoid long dead end streets and give better east-west connections through the plat.
