Although this was a special meeting called to consider recommendation for zoning of the two recently annexed areas, Mr. Archdeacon, Mr. Truzzi and Mr. Abramovitz appeared to discuss possible utilization of the Huber farm under the Residential Development Plan aspect of the current Zoning Ordinance. Mr. Gimbel suggested they also propose some alternate plans for comparison and study. It was pointed out no action could be taken since this area is one of the areas recently incorporated and has yet to be zoned.

A motion was made by Moore and seconded by Schell to recommend zoning the annexed area to the north as shown on the attached map. Voting yes: Moore, Schell, Gimbel, Theiss and Butler. Voting no: none.

A motion was made by Schell and seconded by Moore to recommend zoning the annexed area to the east as shown on the attached map. Voting yes: Schell, Moore, Gimbel, Theiss. Voting no: Butler. Butler felt some of the area to the east should be zoned at least 30,000 sq. ft.
