

Minutes of Feb 23, 1960 Meeting.

Members present - Bumble, Neusong, Schell, Theiss and Gordon.

The minutes were read and a motion was made by Mr Bumble to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Schell, Motion carried.

A letter was read concerning the Washington Township Park committee plan for <sup>future</sup> playgrounds. The letter is attached to these minutes. The Planning commission <sup>voted</sup> ~~approved~~ of the tentative plan to construct new playgrounds rather than a centralized playground. Read letter

Mr Neusong read the letter addressed to Mr Zagle concerning the recommended changes in sewer lines in the Pleasant Hill Plat. The letter was approved and ordered sent. Read letter

The subcommittee, appointed at the previous meeting, to deal with revision of the present ordinances was asked to consider off street parking, set backs, manufacturing districts and restrictive zoning  
*Landmark zoning Resolution*

The procedural guide for the Planning commission was reviewed and modified. Upon a motion by Schell, seconded by Theiss that the guide be adopted as modified a vote was taken. All members voted in favor.

Mr Boggs and Harris, appeared before the board to explain their views on the utilization of the quarry property as a private fishing club. The commission gave Mr Boggs the necessary forms and informed him that a public hearing on his request would be necessary, and as soon as his application is received a public hearing date would be set.

The application of Mr Cottice for re-zoning of his property on Main Street was received. No action was taken as there was insufficient information on the drawings. Mr Shbell will return the forms and check to Mr Cottice with the request that the drawings be corrected.

Motion by Mr Simble, seconded by Shbell that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried. All members voted aye.
