

Minutes of Meeting March 2nd.

Present:- Gemble, Schell, Newwinger, Theiss and Gordon.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and ^{upon} a motion by Theiss seconded by Schell that they be approved - motion carried.

Mr Newwinger stated he had discussed with Mr Williams the need for a new throughfare plan and had asked Mr Williams the cost of constructing such a plan. The council would have to authorize the expenditure, but the Planning Commission voted in favor of requesting the council to authorize Mr Williams to construct the plan.

Mr Williams of Son Development Corp. presented a plan for street changes in their subdivision. Mr Williams had been consulted and had submitted a letter approving the new plan. Upon a motion by Schell, seconded by Gordon that the council approve the change in street ~~map~~ layout. Vote - all aye. Mr Newwinger will present this to the council.

Mr Melbaard Boggs appeared before the commission upon his request for ~~an~~ variance in the ~~zoning~~ zoning ordinance to allow his operation of a private fishing club. He paid the \$15 fee, and submitted his plans. After discussion, a public hearing will be held on April 1st, 1960 at 8 pm in the town hall. The Secretary

was ordered to post notices and notify the neighboring residents.

Mr. John Ziefe appeared before the commission ~~and~~ concerning the request for sewers previously denied by the commission. He agreed to follow ~~the~~ ^{the} recommendations of the Village Engineer and would submit new plans showing the change. Upon receipt of the new drawings the Commission voted to recommend council approval. He also submitted Section 5 of the Pleasant Hill Plat. Approved for submission to the council by unanimous vote.

Mr. Goble moved for adjournment, seconded by Gordon motion carried, meeting adjourned.
