

Meeting of April 12, 1960

Members present:- J. Theiss, B. Newmyer, D. Scheel, T. Gordon.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The sidewalk in Centerville on Sheenan Road was discussed.

Mr. Williams, Village Engineer presented his recommendation on location and construction. He recommended placing it on the North side of the road. He stated typical costs to be 45¢ a sq ft for concrete and 20¢ for blacktop. Mr. Steele representing the people of the area stated he would assist in a canvass of homes of the area for the collection of funds to finance construction. Mr. Newmyer stated he would contact Geo Huffman, owner of the majority of lots as to assistance.

Mr. Newmyer read his report to the council concerning the quarry property and Mr. Boggy's applications. His report was entered into the minutes and is attached.

Washington Township Planning Board has requested a meeting to discuss mutual problems and approaches. The Centerville P. B. members all agreed that such a meeting would be beneficial and Mr. Newmyer will arrange for a date.

The following 3 applications for building permits in Zingle Plat were examined

Lot ~~142~~ 142, Section 5

Upon motion by Gordon, seconded by Shell that the permit be allowed, vote indicated all in favor, motion carried.

Lot 139, Section 5

Due to location of patio cover, it does not meet the zoning code - The application was referred to Board of Zoning Appeal.

Lot 123 and 125 Section 5.

Motion by Gordon, seconded by Shell to approve. Motion carried.

Upon motion by Shell, seconded by Gordon, that the meeting adjourn; all members voted aye.
