Dear Sirs:

I am writing regarding the possibility of opening a day nursery in my home. As you requested when I visited you, I shall try to outline explicitly what the nursery would entail.

The nursery would be conducted from my home, which is located on a half acre at the corner of Colden Gate and Dunsbury Dr. in Washington Park. The number of children attending would be between ten and fifteen. They would be delivered by their parents at 9:00 am and picked up by parents at 11:45 am. Five days a week. I do not believe there would be any traffic problem as probably all the children would come from Washington Park and all parts of the Plat. are in easy walking distance. The children would be under my constant supervision and as the nursery will be held

September thru June they will be indoors
ninety percent of the time and therefore
will not disturb the neighbors.

The outward appearance of my home will
be exactly as the others in the plot and I feel
the nursery would be accepted and I hope
wanted by most everyone.

I am qualified to teach and work with a
nursery group I believe, having majored in
education at college. I've also had seven years
Scout work, fifteen years teaching Sunday
School and am presently heading a staff of
seven in the nursery at Forest Ave. Presbyterian
church. I hope my plans meet with your
approval. I shall be anxiously awaiting your
reply.
