My dear Mr. Mayor:

In a meeting of the Centerville Planning Board on February 25, 1958, the 753.249 acres located adjacent to the northwest corner of Centerville known as Normandy Farms, bounded on the west by McEwen Road, on the north by the north boundary line of the Grant estate, on the east by S. R. 48 and on the south by the south line of the Grant estate, was zoned as R-1 Resident (20,000 square feet) in accordance with the Centerville zoning ordinance. It is therefore our recommendation to Council that the zoning be accepted for the above proposed annexation.
