The application of Braut L. Funkhouser to build a breezeway between the existing brick house and garage for James Bird at 49 Wiedner Lane was accepted. This application was approved of 9/28/56 after acceptance over telephone of the members.

Application of W. Hetzer Jr. for construction of a ranch type dwelling on Lot 112 at 154 East Franklin valued at \$14000⁰⁰ was received. Lot #112 in Wiedner Second Addition. Approved by members present after increase in floor area up to specifications.

Application of Henry Hooker for a residence at 124 Franklin St. on Lot #113 of the Wiedner plat. Approximate value \$16,000.

Application approved by members present. Original application on Sept 10, 1956 was disapproved but the re-submitted drawing as approved decreased the house dimensions in order to provide the proper side clearance.

Application for alterations at residence of Mr. A.V. Black at 17 N. Main St. to convert into office space for his practice was disapproved. Engineer requested to obtain drawing of plan which will show existing and changes to building.
