A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CITY SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES FOR A 2020 CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING PROGRAM GRANT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES TO MITIGATE COVID-19 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS AS NECESSARY TO FACILITATE SUCH GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio provided a grant through the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) for COVID-19 supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville through its Police Department sought grant funding for such supplies and equipment assistance; and

WHEREAS, the OCJS approved of the City's request for the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City hereby ratifies all actions taken to submit and apply for and obtain the OCJS Grant as described above.


SECTION 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
