- Art Gallery: There are still open spots for 2016, members were asked to continue submitting names for consideration. Lucille Nagy Carroll is the artist for December. At the time of our meeting, she was undecided on whether or not she will have a reception. Dan Patterson is the featured artist for AATT and will be installed in the Art Gallery for January 2016.
- Art at the Trace: Dan Patterson is the featured artist. 23 artists were chosen with 7 more on reserve. There is also 1 spot open for an emerging artist. Detailed contracts will be sent. Tickets are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the door. Doors open at 6:30 – 9 p.m. Discussed a possibility of having an emerging artist as the featured artist for 2017.
- Classical Committee: Holiday Walk carolers and children's opera have been approved for 2016. Tom has an opera scheduled with the Dayton Opera. Discussed Original Night and Trans Siberian Orchestra workshop at the high school.
- Digital Photo Contest: Has concluded. Winners are on display through November.
- Summer Concert Series: Discussed minimizing big bands this year. Jim proposes "Elvis Night"; he will pass around CD's for us to listen to. 8 bands are up for consideration as well as having a Saturday night rock band or Elvis instead of dance night. Final decisions need to be made at our January meeting.
- New Business: Members were asked to continue to look for new board members and ask neighbors, etc.
