

ORDINANCE NO. 12 - 1940.

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY AND STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, That, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Centerville during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1940, the following additional sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 1. That there be transferred from the General Fund to the Safety Fund the sum of \$6.70; and that there be appropriated from said Safety Fund the following:

B. 12	Traffic Lights	\$ 6.70
	Total Safety Fund	\$ 6.70

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the Water Fund the following:

D. 3	Fuel and Light	\$ 91.16
D. 5	Repairs to Pipes and Machinery	2.79
D. 9x	New Meters	<u>19.22</u>
	Total Water Fund	\$113.17

Section 3. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
