ORDINANCE NUMBER 9 - 1957

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF A DEPUTY MARSHAL.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to employ and appoint a Deputy Marshal, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 737.16, and that the officer so appointed shall continue in office until removed therefrom for cause and in the manner provided by Ohio Revised Code Section 737.15.

Section 2. The duly appointed Deputy Marshal shall furnish a fidelity bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) given by a corporate surety acceptable to Council.

Section 3. That such Deputy Marshal so appointed shall be compensated at the rate of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per hour for each hour on duty, and shall act in the public welfare and safety subject to the direct control and supervision of the Village Marshal.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance is passed as an emergency measure for the reason that recent increases in territory and population necessitate immediate assistance to the Village Marshal in effectuating the welfare, safety and convenience of the citizens of the Village, and shall take effect immediately.
