**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 211,  
INVESTMENT AND DEPOSIT POLICY, OF THE  
CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 211 of the Centerville Municipal Code established the Investment and Deposit Policy for the City of Centerville; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 211 was initially adopted by Resolution No. 50-02 and later replaced by Ordinance No. 29-07; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no requirement for the City's Investment and Deposit Policy to be codified; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council has determined that it wants an Investment and Deposit Policy, but there is no need to codify such policy; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council wishes to formally take action to abolish Chapter 211 of the Centerville Municipal Code with the intent to then adopt a new Investment and Deposit Policy for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 211, Investment and Deposit Policy, of the Centerville Municipal Code shall be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
