Staff Report: We will be receiving new name tags with the new logo at the next meeting. Progress Stability is on-going. Veterans Day will be virtual. No breakfast is scheduled. Halloween will be celebrated in its normal manner. The tree lighting at Benham's Grove will be November 22, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. outside with the barn as the backdrop. The dedication of the art sculpture scheduled for November at Cornerstone will take place in the Spring to include the Arts Commission. It is decided to dissolve the organization of "Friends of Benham Grove". Kate provided the photos for the photo contest to the commission to select 12 choices for consideration. We are to submit suggestions in November. The photos will be located at the Art Gallery in December. The Mayor will present the winner.

Interactive: 85 photos were submitted for the photo contest. Possible participation in World Affair at the Library is being considered. Terry has a \$1500 grant for Friday events in 2021.

Concert Series: Jim indicated we have 20 groups scheduled for 2021. For July, the fireworks and the Community Band will take place on Sunday at CHS. Americana will be on Monday.

New/Old Business: City Uptown project will have a friendly walk traffic between 725 and 48. The first phase will be behind Northeast Barbecue. Use back doors for entry. Benches will be available for use. A vibrant public mural is being considered. The Centerville Council is increasing the 5-year budget by \$10,000.00. The Arts budget will also increase. An LED Marquee at Stubb's Park and at the Pocket Park is on the agenda for discussion.
