The following information was revealed during discussion of property tax plans for the year 1985:

1. The City of Centerville will not ask the electorate for a police levy renewal in 1985.
2. In all probability, there will be a school levy on the ballot sometime during 1985, time and amount to be determined.
3. There will be a police renewal or new operating levy placed on the ballot by Washington Township during 1985.

Mr. Donald Sortman, President of the Rotary Club, was present to explain their proposal to place "Home of the Centerville Elks, State Champions in" signs at most appropriate entrances into the Centerville Community. Added to these signs would be smaller signs identifying specific achievements. Mr. Kenning, Mr. Morton and Dr. Overly will refine details and present their proposal to Washington Township and the City of Centerville for review.

Mr. Morton and Mr. Kenning reviewed road improvements which will take place in the Centerville area during 1985 and 1986.

Mr. Whitaker reviewed the report of the Task Force and its implementation relative to the designated smoking areas and open lunch policy at the Centerville High School. These privileges will continue to exist with penalties for violators.


Dr. Cleary defined the Latch Key Program as being very receptive by those participating, however, participation has been small in number. It is intended at this time to continue the program for another year.



Mr. Morton explained the charge of a Community Education Officer recently employed by Washington Township and occupying an office in the Centerville High School. Activities of this Officer will be similar to those of Centerville's Crime Prevention Officer.

Mr. Kenning outlined needs to improve traffic conditions around the Centerville High School. The City will continue to make minor adjustments to minimize these conditions.

Representatives from the three entities involved in this Meeting agreed that the Centerville-Washington Park District be included in future Joint Meetings and that another Meeting be scheduled in approximately six months. This Meeting will be coordinated by Mr. Kenning, Mr. Morton and Dr. Overly.
