Mr. Daley reviewed the Historical Society's revenue and expenses for the year 1999 and projected for 2000 relative to the Walton House and the Asahel Wright House. \$60,000.00 was contributed by each entity (Centerville and Washington Township) for the year 1999. Mr. Horn pointed out that there is approximately \$5,000.00-\$10,000.00 remaining in the budgeted \$120,000.00 for 1999. Members of City Council and Township Trustees concurred that this overage be placed in a reserve fund to cover beginning operations in the year 2000. It was also agreed that each entity would contribute \$63,000.00 to the Historical Society for operations at the Walton House and Asahel Wright House for the year 2000.

Mrs. Young pointed out that the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission Transportation Committee is preparing a five year transportation plan. She cautioned all public officials to stay abreast of this plan. Mayor Beals advised that also being discussed is a 25 year plan.

Mrs. Young announced the following dates for National Issues Forums in the beginning of the year 2000: January 13, February 10, and March 9; topics to be discussed are Urban Sprawl and Air Cargo Noise.
