**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO APPLY FOR THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT GRANT FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF RECYCLED PLAYGROUND MATTING FOR PLAYGROUNDS AT STUBBS PARK, AND THE PURCHASE OF BIGBELLY SOLAR DUAL WASTE AND RECYCLING KIOSKS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THEREWITH.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Centerville is committed to reducing waste and increasing recycling participation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Centerville is making enhancements within Stubbs Park to accessibility and sustainable development; and

**WHEREAS**, the Montgomery County Solid Waste District is accepting applications for the 2022 District Incentive grant cycle, with waste reduction, and reuse/repurpose as two focus funding priorities.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:
