ORDINANCE NO. 02-22

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Mark Engert ON THE 10<sup>th</sup> DAY OF January, 2022.

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FEES AND CHARGES FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.


WHEREAS, the City has installed three Electrical Vehicle Charging Stations at the Municipal Building and in Uptown; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to charge fees to recoup the costs of maintenance expenses for the equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

- Section 1. That the City of Centerville shall charge a fee of \$1.00 per hour for the use of the electrical vehicle charging stations.
- Section 2. That the City Manage may adjust the fees up to ten percent (10%) annually without the need for City Council action, but any such increases are to be reported to City Council.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
