**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A SUBGRANT AWARD GRANT AGREEMENT WITH STATE
OF OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES FOR
GRANT OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF BODY CAMERAS.**

WHEREAS, the City is desirous to body cameras for the Centerville police department; and

WHEREAS, the City sought a State grant to assist in the purchase of the body cameras; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Recovery Ohio Law Enforcement provisions of Section 373.20, Justice Program Services, of Am. Sub. H.B. No. 110 of the 134th Ohio General Assembly, enacted June 29, 2021, the Ohio office of Criminal Justice Services, approved the project application submitted by the City of Centerville for body cameras (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, OCJS agrees to provide the City with \$115,000.00 to be used for the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Subgrant Award Agreement with Ohio office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) for the funding of \$115,000 towards the police body camera Project, a copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein on behalf of the City of Centerville.

Section 2. That both the City Manager and the Chief of police are authorized to take all steps necessary and to execute any additional documents to facilitate the grant from OCJS.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
