A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND THE CENTERVILLE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PRESENCE OF POLICE OFFICERS IN SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville provides police protection to all areas of the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Centerville City School District has determined that it has a special need for the presence of City police officers at its school buildings located within the corporate limits within the City as a precautionary measure against possible acts of violence; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.951 allows the City and the School District to memorialize their understanding in a Memorandum of Understanding; and


WHEREAS, the parties hereto wish to execute a Memorandum of Understanding as the agreement recording their understanding as to how the City will supply the extra police protection to the School, the method of compensation and other related matters.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement between the City of Centerville and the Centerville City School District to provide for the presence of City police officers at school buildings located within the corporate limits of the City of Centerville.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
