A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO APPLY FOR A GREATER DAYTON REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (RTA) COMMUNITY GRANT FOR CAPITAL REINVESTMENT AT RTA BUS STOPS FOR BIG BELLY WASTE KIOSKS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority (RTA) administers a Community Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville, Ohio, desires financial assistance under the Community Grant Program for assistance with the Big Belly Waste Kiosks at bus stops within the City of Centerville.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville City Council approves of the filing of an application for the RTA Community Grant for financial assistance for the Big Belly Waste Kiosks at bus stops within the City of Centerville.

Section 2. That the City Manager and/or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the RTA, as set forth in Exhibit "A", incorporated herein, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to enter into an agreement for the grant, as necessary.


Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

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Project Narrative

The City of Centerville plans to purchase fourteen (14) high-capacity solar-powered waste kiosks for placement in the City's gazebos that are located throughout the city at Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority (RTA) bus stops. Placing the kiosks in these areas will allow for proper disposal of waste, reduce varmint intrusion, and reduce City operating costs. The kiosks will have customized wrapping, that include the City's logo. The graphic could be co-branded with RTA in recognition of the funding at RTA's request.
