RESOLUTION NO. 7/-22 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Jo Ance Ray ON THE DAY OF September, 2022.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED AGREEMENT FOR UPGRADING THE CITY'S MICROSOFT 365 LICENSING.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville had been improving and updating its information technology (IT) systems in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City migrated to its Exchange to Microsoft 365 for Exchange; and

WHEREAS, this City Council adopted Resolution No. 68-20 on October 5, 2020 to allow for the migration to the Microsoft 365 hybrid at an annual cost of \$48,774.96; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining increased security by using Multi Factor Authorization Security; and

WHEREAS, the Microsoft Licensing cost will require an increase up to \$61,347.24 for this additional security; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code recognizes exceptions to competitive bidding for professional services and for purchases related to IT that are proprietary or limited to a sole source; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 125.02 grants authority for the City to use State terms for pricing schedules allowing such purchases without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contracts appear on the ODAS State Term Schedule (OH STS OA1252) pricelist; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City for this upgrade its licensing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City hereby agrees to increase its Microsoft Licensing up to \$61,347.24 per year.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized to take all steps necessary to execute any additional documents for the increase in its Microsoft Licensing including, but not limited to, any Microsoft Volume Licensing agreement documents.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
