A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACTION OF THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, IN AUTHORIZING THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO SUBMIT A DAYTON REGION PRIORITY DEVELOPMENT AND ADVOCACY COMMITTEE (PDAC) APPLICATION TO THE DAYTON DEVELOPMENT COALITION FOR THE WILMINGTON PIKE/I-675 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Dayton Development Coalition established the PDAC to assist in establishing regional priorities for funding public projects that benefit the economic development, transportation, health, education or quality of life in the region; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the Wilmington Pike/I-675 Interchange Improvement Project as a community and regional transportation priority; and

WHERAS, Greene County and Sugarcreek Township have also identified the Wilmington Pike/ I-675 Interchange Improvement Project as a community and regional transportation priority; and

WHEREAS, the three entities wish to jointly submit a PDAC application for the project; and

WHEREAS, the submittal deadline for 2022 PDAC applications is November 4, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the action of the City Manager to authorize the Montgomery County Transportation Improvement District to submit a PDAC application for the Wilmington Pike/I-675 Interchange Improvement Project with Greene County and Sugarcreek Township.

Section 2. This resolution becomes effective on the earliest date allowed by law.
