NEW BUSINESS:

Four Corners

- Budget for 2023 is anticipated to be \$20,000.
- For a new landscape design, use a professional landscaping company (i.e., Siebenthalers, Grandma's Gardens) Siebenthalers has previously said they would like to be involved.
- *Nancy, Carol, and Bob volunteered for the subcommittee, and they will present plans to the Commission for vote/approval. Debbie will provide the subcommittee with the notes from the Commission's previous meeting/suggestions with Grandma's Gardens. Secured irrigation drawing to assist with planning.*

See below regarding recommendation:

- Following up on Sherry's suggestion, Drew will discuss with the city to utilize their internal horticulturist for a new Four Corners Landscaping design with CBC input.
- Present potential options to the CBC for input and selection in lieu of a CBC sub-committee.
- It is too late to redesign the beds in time for Spring planting therefore, the goal is to select a new design over the next 6-8 months then plant the foundational trees/shrubs at the end of the 2023 flower season. The CBC would plant annuals that supplement the new design in Spring 2024.
