Walter Barineau stated there are various challenges with the lot. He indicated there may be a reconfiguration of the parking lot once he has more clarity on the status of an easement that runs across the front of the site. Mr. Barineau expressed he would welcome any feedback from the Commission.

Mr. Barineau, Commission members, and staff discussed:

- 1. The cooler needs to tie into the building and look like part of the structure.
- 2. Examples of other coolers in Centerville that meet this requirement and the elements that could help tie it to the building.
- 3. Four-sided architecture requirement.
- 4. Additional south wall aesthetic relief is required such as faux windows with awnings.

Mr. Barineau indicated he would take the feedback and recommendations and have his team make revisions.
