Summary of Discussions							

Summary of Discussions

- Review and approval of previous meetings minutes (Bob Lentz)
- Capital planning overview (Turnbull)
 - o Reviewed the City's Capital Improvement budget that was approved by Council in December.
 - Described how the City practices 5-year budgeting
- Uptown and Stubbs investment in stormwater enhancements (Turnbull)
 - Discussed how both projects will detain 20% of the runoff of the previously developed impervious areas which will reduce the rate of run-off and improve water quality
- Gracewood ditch and Milbank projects (Swanson)
 - Reviewed the 3 alternatives reviewed and selected for the Gracewood ditch project. The simplest alternative was selected. Least invasive to property owners, most practical solution that would address the majority of the problems.
 - Discussed public outreach efforts and public meeting to be included in Gracewood. Public meeting and information to be shared with residents.
 - o Gracewood is on schedule for 4/14/23 design completion.
 - Updated city's progress on the Millbank design. Flow calculations completed.
 - Easement will probably be required from at least one resident. They have been supportive of the project so far.
- Ditch Inspections (Swanson)
 - Reviewed ditch inspection goal and process, reviewed maps and charts, updated on progress (60%) and gave example of how the forms are used.
 - Case study with overflowing sanitary cleanout was shared.
 - o Initial feedback shared. Group suggested used of tablet and drones as way to improve process.
 - SHD committee members agreed to help audit program.
 - SHD Committee members invited to join on spring inspections.
- Stormwater education (Swanson)
 - Gracewood Ditch
 - Will conduct public meetings and outreach as part of the project.
 - Will gauge interest from residents receiving information to see what kind of engagement we can expect.

- Native plant month education
 - Webpage will be created with education info on native plants
 - Other conservancy groups in the area host native plant sales. Possibility to promote with our materials.
- Rain barrel availability and education
- Riversmart program through Miami Conservancy has several useful resources. Specifically a commercial that was made.
- o City to utilize work of other stakeholder groups who are involved with stormwater education.
- Stormwater maintenance program update (Schindler)
 - SOP for storing, processing, and decision making
 - GIS map editor will be utilized
 - Inspections will begin with streets being paved in 2023 (Clyo, Loop, W AB, Rose Estates)
 - Starting field work in March when winter weather ends
 - Determine this year how much work in one year, condition of area, types of failures, costs
- Other stormwater or roadway topics? (Chair)
 - John Palcher conveyed a citizen's request for more sidewalk connectivity. Specifically along Wilmington Pike and Alex-Bell
 - Safe routes to school will be revised in the near future, SHD committee could be involved with that process.
 - Members encouraged to bring information ideas back from neighbors to the group for potential projects or programs.
 - Ohio EPA is being pressured by EPA to conduct more audits on MS4 program.
 - SHD members will conduct self-audit of 2023 stormwater plan in April after it is submitted
