Mayor Compton called the Work Session meeting to order at 5:32 P.M.

Budget Presentation

Mr. Davis opened the review discussing key assumptions of the budget forecast. He noted the fund balance health. Mr. Davis also discussed personnel and wage adjustments which will come before City Council in the pay ordinance at Monday night's meeting.

Mr. Roark spoke about the budget process. He reminded that City Council will, when approving the budget, only be appropriating for one year while the other four years are presented as forecast only.

Mr. Roark discussed the 2024 fund analysis and balances, revenue assumptions, and expense assumptions. He noted that City Council will be acting upon a \$71 million budget. He informed that income tax collection is up 3.5 percent through October.

Mr. Roark reviewed the revenue and expense projections and forecasts for the General Government Fund. He then directed each department head to present their departmental operating budget and capital budget.

Each department head reviewed their departmental budget requests, addressing staffing, professional services, departmental initiatives, and capital improvement expenditures such as equipment, facilities improvements, and vehicles.
