

Utility Billing Customer Self Service Single Sign-on Option

1. Select **Services** from the menu at <u>centervilleohio.gov</u>.



2. Click **Pay Online.** You will then be redirected to Munis Self Service. Select **Citizen Self Service** from the banner on the left.

 - b. Using an existing password on Apple, Facebook, Google or Microsoft.

1. Click the **Sign In** link for your preferred application. The username and password used for the selected application will become the username and password for your City of Centerville utility billing account.

2. You will receive an email from Community Access (OKTA). Verify your email and activate by clicking **Activate Account.**

IMPORTANT: If you choose to register with Google, Facebook, Apple or Microsoft, you may only use that option to log in to your customer account. You will be unable to change your password through your utility billing account when registering your credentials through an application.

- 4. Log in to your account using your new username and password.
- 5. Under Account Settings, click Link to Utility Billing Account (not customer).

Helpful Hints

- You cannot register an email ending in gmail.com, icloud.com, hotmail.com, outlook.com or facebook.com. You must use the application single sign-on option.
- You cannot use the reset password link for accounts ending in gmail.com, apple.com, hotmail.com, outlook.com or facebook.com.
- If you sign in with Apple, you will be redirected to <u>icloud.com</u>. After logging in with iCloud, you will be redirected back to your City of Centerville customer account.
- If you sign in with Facebook, you will be redirected to <u>facebook.com</u>. After logging in with Facebook, you will be redirected back to your City of Centerville customer account.
- If you sign in with Google, you will be redirected to <u>accounts.google.com</u>. After logging in with Google, you will be redirected back to your City of Centerville customer account.
- If you sign in with Microsoft, you will be redirected to <u>microsoftonline.com</u>. After logging in with Microsoft, you will be redirected back to your City of Centerville customer account.
- Apple, Facebook, Google and Microsoft will not have access to your City of Centerville customer account.
