**ORDINANCE NO.15-24**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A RESTATED, REVISED, AND REAFFIRMED THOROUGHFARE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.**

**WHEREAS**, in 1971 the City of Centerville participated in the funding and preparation of a comprehensive plan, which included a Traffic and Transportation Plan for the City of Centerville; and

**WHEREAS**, the Traffic and Transportation Plan, commonly known as the Thoroughfare Plan was originally adopted by the Council of the City of Centerville on December 6, 1971; and

**WHEREAS**, the Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Centerville was revised by Resolution 5-94 and Resolution 46-11; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Centerville, Sugarcreek Township, and Greene County have been working with the Montgomery County Transportation Improvement District (MCTID) and ODOT on developing a plan to improve the roadway network in the area around the Wilmington Pike and I-675 Interchange, known as the Wilmington Project Access Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire to incorporate the Wilmington Project Access Management Plan as an addendum to the Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Centerville; and

**WHEREAS**, the Centerville Planning Commission, following a public hearing, recommended adoption of an addendum to the Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Centerville to include the Wilmington Project Access Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City to reaffirm, re-adopt, and accept all revisions to the Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Centerville through this ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1. That the Traffic and Transportation Plan, more commonly referred to as the “Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Centerville”, is hereby reaffirmed and re-adopted; and which has been updated as recommended by the Planning Commission to incorporate the Wilmington Project Access Management Plan,

be hereby adopted for the City of Centerville. A copy of the Thoroughfare Plan is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date provided by law.
