A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL
SUBMITTED BY DUKE'S ROOT CONTROL, INC. OF
ELGIN ILLINOIS FOR STORM SEWER CAMERA
INSPECTION AND REPAIRS AND AUTHORIZING THE
CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN
CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, City Council on or about April 1, 2024, adopted
Resolution 39-24 authorizing the City to join the Houston-Galveston Area
Council (hereinafter "H-GAC") is an innovative cooperative purchasing
organization for competitively bid contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is a member of the H-GAC
purchasing cooperative: and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville sought proposals for storm sewer
camera inspection and repairs through the H-GAC purchasing cooperative:
and

WHEREAS, the proposal was competitively bid through the H-GAC
Buy contract SC06-24: and

WHEREAS, **Dukes Root Control, Inc of Elgin, Illinois** provided the
best and lowest proposal for the contracted services.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by **Dukes Root Control, Inc
of Elgin, Illinois** for Storm Sewer Camera Inspection and Repairs, is hereby
accepted in the amount of \$80,000.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to do all things
necessary to execute a contract **Dukes Root Control, Inc of Elgin, Illinois**,
as stated above.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
