camera inspection and repairs through the H-GAC purchasing cooperative:
and

WHEREAS, the proposal was competitively bid through the H-GAC
Buy contract SC06-24: and

WHEREAS, **Insight Pipe Contracting, LLC of Harmony
Pennsylvania** provided the best and lowest proposal for the contracted
services.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
